

## **Cumbræ**

The Isle of Great Cumbræ, which is a very short ferry trip from Largs, is only 4 miles long and two miles wide making the bicycle a popular form of transport. Why not hire a bike and cycle around the island. There are few hills along the way and the views are fabulous in every direction.

It's worth stopping in Millport for a while and enjoying the sights. It is home to the Cathedral of the Isles, the smallest cathedral in Europe. The Marine Biological Station has been a research centre for over 100 years and has an excellent aquarium. Also worth a visit is the Museum of the Cumbræes.
